Biomedical Admissions Test (BMAT)

About BMAT

BMAT is a subject-specific admissions test taken by applicants to certain medicine, veterinary medicine.

The BMAT is owned and administered by Cambridge Assessment. The BMAT is a 2 hour test in 3 sections:

Section 1: Aptitude & Skills	60 minutes (multiple-choice)
Section 2: Scientific Knowledge & Applications	30 minutes (multiple-choice)
Section 3: Writing Task	30 minutes (Essay question)

Before register

1. Ensure you have understood all information about BMAT test format.
2. Read all information in the **Registration Guide**, **Registration form** and **Notice to Candidate**.

How to register

1. Complete an application form:

- You can save and resume your application.

2. Submit required documents

- A copy of your passport or Indonesia National ID Card (KTP)
- Consent form signed by your guardian (If your age is below 18)
- Payment slip (If you make a payment via bank transfer)

3. Make a payment

3.1) Bank Transfer

- Transfer the exam fee to British Council bank account, upload the payment slip and submit your application on the transfer date

3.2) In-person at British Council Indonesia Foundation

- Show confirmation email of your submitted application to Exams Customer Management Team
- Cash is not accepted

Late entries	01 October 2020 – 14 October 2020	IDR 4,224,000

After registration

A confirmation email with your entry number, test venue and any updates will be sent to you by 26 October 2020

On the test day

1. Please present your Thai national ID card or passport as a proof of identity. You will not be allowed to take the test without the proof of identity above.
2. Please bring your own stationery. Black ball point pen and soft pencil are required for the test.
3. You will receive your pin to view your result online

14:00	ID Check
14:45	BMAT test instructions
15:00-18:00	BMAT Section 1-3

You will not be allowed to take the test if you arrive later than **14:30

After the test

Results will be released via Results Online system on 27 November 2020 which only valid for the year of application to university. Results will not be provided in hard copies. If you have applied to a university which does not appear on the list, you will be responsible for providing your result to the university directly.
