NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS (NO PAPER RESULTS WILL BE ISSUED)

- **BMAT** - A Statement of Results will be issued to each candidate on 27 November 2020. Candidates may access their results using their log-in credentials. The results go to any BMAT institution a candidate has applied to.
 - **BMAT Inquiry on Results deadline** – 03 December 2020
- **TSA Oxford and ELAT** - A Statement of Results will be issued to each candidate on 11 January 2021. Candidates may access their results using their log-in credentials. The results will be passed to the Oxford College where the candidate has applied to.
- **PAT/ HAT/ MAT/ MLAT/ CAT/ OLAT/ PHIL** - Test results are not published automatically. Candidates may request their test score from their respective colleges as part of the usual University of Oxford feedback process

TEST RESULTS

Your submission must arrive by **Thursday, 03 December 2020**. To complete your submission, you must fill out the relevant form - an Application for Results Enquiry. You may send your completed form by post (Special Delivery or equivalent) or as a scanned email attachment to the BMAT Support Team, using the address, fax number or email address given on the relevant form. Candidates who took the test at an open centre can submit the Results Enquiry or Appeal form directly to the Admissions Testing Service without an accompanying covering letter.

Please note: Results can go down as well as up as a result of this process, which could affect a candidate's university application.
